IT IS ORDERED:

1. This case is ordered to mediation under MCR 3.216 on the Court's own motion.
2. The mediator will be selected by the agreement of the parties. The mediator must be selected no later than 30 days after service on the defendant. Within that same 30 days the Judge must be notified of the name of the mediator or that the parties cannot agree on a mediator. If no mediator is selected the ADR Clerk will appoint a mediator.
3. At or before a pre-trial conference a proposed temporary consent order must be presented to the Judge that sets forth the parties' interim (1) parenting arrangement, including child support; (2) financial arrangement (protection of assets, payment of bills, etc.); (3) any other preliminary matter relevant to the case. The parties are also urged to continue mediation to achieve a final settlement.
4. Costs of mediation shall be divided by the parties *pro-rata*, unless otherwise agreed by the parties or ordered by the court; or for persons unable to pay, as provided by the court's ADR plan.
5. Parties are to attend mediation sessions, as directed by the mediator; attorneys may attend.
6. The plaintiff or plaintiff's attorney shall serve a copy of this Order for Mediation on the defendant, along with the Complaint and Summons.
7. The plaintiff or plaintiff's attorney shall additionally complete the accompanying Response to Order for Mediation. If this case is exempt from mediation, please indicate why on the Response sheet.
8. The completed Response sheet must be returned to the Circuit Court Services Office with the Proof of Service showing service of the Complaint, Summons and Order to Mediate.
