ALCOHOL MONITORING SYSTEM AGREEMENT**

The MEMS Alcohol Monitoring System provides a level of surveillance for your presence within your residence to monitor alcohol within your system. Failure to comply with the rules of the program may result in termination from the program and return to custody at the Washtenaw County Jail.

1. You must be in the confines of your residence during the times designated by your Supervision Agent.
2. You may only go to work or a destination authorized by your Supervision Agent.
3. You must maintain electrical and compatible telephone services at your residence at your own expense. You are responsible for telephone charges incurred from normal use of the monitoring equipment. You will provide copies of your telephone bill when requested by your Supervision Agent.
4. You must not have any options on the telephone line to which the equipment is connected. This includes any external devices used to forward telephone calls such as caller ID, call waiting, call forwarding, answering machines, voicemail, or any blocks on your telephone. The telephone line can not be a digital line.
5. You must not have a telephone answering machine connected to your phone during curfew hours.
6. You will be receiving random telephone calls during the time that you are to be at home. You must respond to these calls by taking the tests and sending the results along with your picture. Your telephone will ring eight (8) times before registering as a "no answer". When there is no response result, the computer automatically calls back 1-2 times with in 3 – 7 minutes.
7. You must not take your phone off the hook. You must not turn off your telephone ringer or unplug your telephone. If you should have telephone problems you must obtain written documentation from your telephone carrier. You must make sure that everyone in your residence understands and complies with these rules.
8. To avoid busy signals, your telephone must not be in use for more than five (5) minutes at a time.
9. You must respond personally to telephone calls to verify that you are home.
10. If there is an emergency situation during your confinement hours, call and leave a message with your Supervision Agent. Be prepared to provide verification of any interruption of your curfew time.

11. You must reimburse Washtenaw County Community Corrections for all program costs at a rate of \$15.00 per day. The schedule for your payments will be on your assigned report day. You will also be charged a one-time \$100.00 enrollment fee.
12. You must reimburse Washtenaw County Community Corrections for all repairs to or replacement of equipment that is damaged or lost, if it has been determined by your Supervision Agent or Community Corrections Director to be your responsibility. You will be prosecuted for equipment that is not returned.
13. You must contact your Supervision Agent for curfew changes. DO NOT contact the MEMS computer center for a curfew change. All changes to your curfew must be requested and approved between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Monday – Friday. Washtenaw County Community Corrections is not open on the week ends or holidays.
14. You must contact your Supervision Agent if you suspect problems with the MEMS System equipment. During non-business hours you will call your Supervision Agent and leave a message including your name, date, time, and the nature of your problem.
15. You must make a truthful report to your Supervision Agent as often as s/he requires.
16. You must attend all scheduled court appointments and comply with conditions of probation or bond.
17. Not violate any criminal law of any unit of government.
18. Remain within the State of Michigan unless granted permission by the Court in the form of a travel pass.
19. Do not possess or use alcohol, illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia. You may be required to submit to random drug testing and/or Breathalyzer tests as a condition of electronic monitoring. You will be responsible for reimbursement of these fees.
20. You must secure and maintain employment within 15 days after installation of MEMS Monitoring System.
5. Participate in any substance abuse treatment, educational, or employment programs as directed by your Supervision Agent. Must provide proof of attendance to your Supervision Agent as requested.
6. I understand that I am to be held responsible for the Alcohol Monitoring System equipment B#_____. I will not tamper with or attempt to fix, nor will I allow anyone else to tamper with or attempt to fix the equipment. All equipment will be returned to Washtenaw County Community Corrections upon termination from the program. The equipment is valued at \$3,000.00.
7. Additional Conditions: You will be charged an additional \$100 enrollment fee should you be switched to a different electronic monitoring system.

I hereby acknowledge that I have read, or had read to me, the above conditions. I understand that failure to comply with these conditions may result in a violation of my bond, probation, or conditional (early) jail release.
